1. Professors invited from abroad with public lessons / courses in the Bachelor, Master and Doctoral programmes.
2. International accreditation of study programs.

5. Elaboration of common teaching materials, including electronic format (e.g. Birds).
6. Supervising Bachelor, Master and Doctoral theses in co-tutorship.
