
Exchange students mobility

- International practices in LT embassies, lithuanian schools abroad (2015-2016 – 8 scholarships)
- Master scholarships for targeted countries (2015-2016 – 19 incoming from UA,MD; 2016-2017 – 18 incoming from UA, AZ, 2017-2018 – 21 incoming from UA)
- NordPlus network mobility grants (Faculty of Law)
- ESF Projects for JSP implementation shall include financing of compulsory mobility (from 2018)

Challenges

- Expectations for growth in incoming students numbers
- Decrease in outgoing Erasmus student numbers – partly due to higher interest in other possibilities
- Additional funding for students mobility to facilitate studies under bilateral agreements (and for compulsory mobility under JSP...)
- Facilitation of visiting professors schemes
